



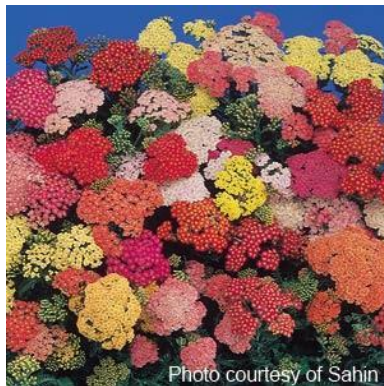

Achillea (Yarrow) Coronation Gold

Low maintenance, upright perennial with golden flower clusters. Blooms 6-8 weeks beginning in July.

- Best in sun
- Height 18-24 in. Spread 12-18 in.
- Drought tolerant
- Prefers good, well-drained soil
- Good cut or dried flower
- Resistant to deer, rabbits*
- Attracts butterflies and other pollinators
- May rebloom if cut back after flowering



Achillea Millefolium (Common Yarrow) Summer Pastels

Low maintenance, upright perennial with flower clusters in assorted colors. Blooms 2-3 months beginning in July.

- Best in sun
- Height 15-18 in. Spread 12-18 in.
- Drought and salt tolerant
- Prefers good, well-drained soil
- Good cut or dried flower
- Resistant to deer, rabbits*
- Attracts butterflies and other pollinators

- Resistant to deer, resistant*

Aquilegia (Columbine) Origami Mix

Upright perennial with large flowers in a mix of colors.

- Attracts butterflies and hummingbirds

Clumping perennial with large variegated, heart shaped leaves in silver and green and clouds of blue flowers. Blooms spring to summer.

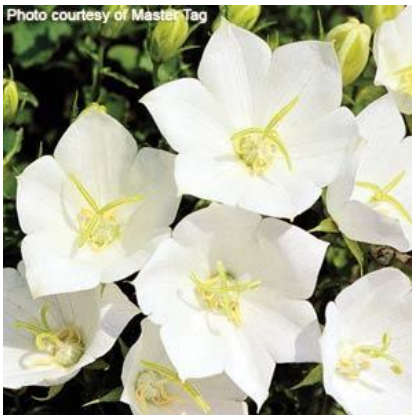

- Prefers moist, well-drained soil.

Cleome Hassleriana (Spider Flower)



Heirloom

Upright annual often treated as a perennial as it self-seeds readily. It has dramatic rose-pink flower clusters on scented foliage. Blooms late summer to fall.

- Prefers well-drained soil

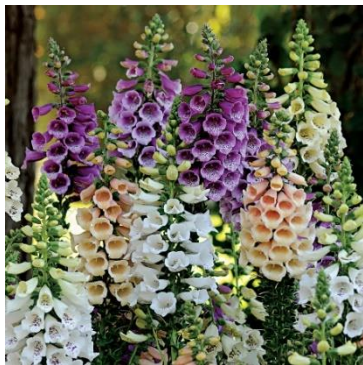

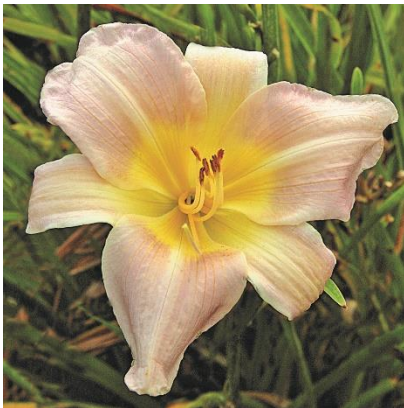

- Prefers rich, well-drained soil
- Tolerates salt, heat, humidity, dry shady locations

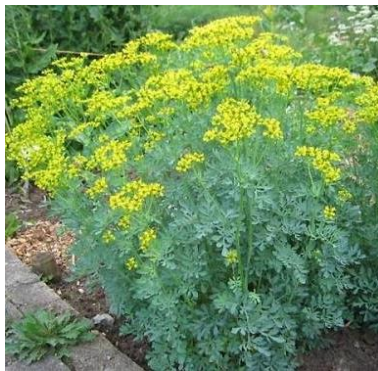

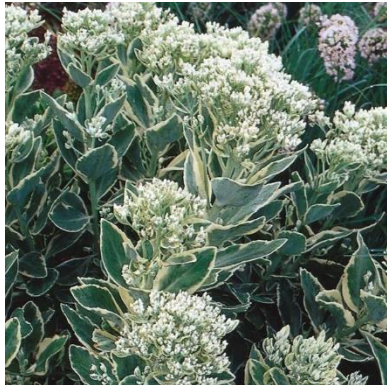

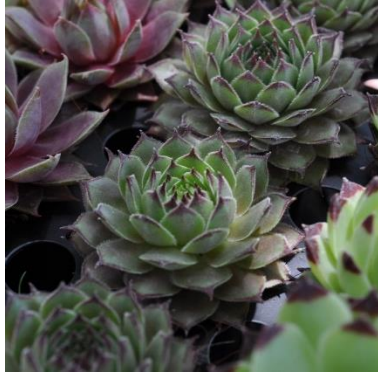
