## Arborvitae, Emerald (Smaragd)

### *Thuja occidentalis* 'Smaragd'



Compact columnar evergreen with emerald-green foliage. Great as a privacy screen, hedge, or windscreen. Planted in two parallel rows, they create a wonderful sense of perspective. Single specimens also make a great focal point.

- Plant type – conifer/evergreen
- Full to part sun

- Growth rate – Slow

- Water frequently in extreme heat.
- Requires less water once established

## Hydrangea, Bobo *Hydrangea paniculata* 'ILVOBO'



Compact deciduous shrub with rich green foliage and white flower panicles that continue to lengthen as they bloom. Flowers bloom on sturdy stems from July to September, taking on pink and purple hues as they age. Prolific bloomer. Great in mixed borders and foundation plantings.

## Hydrangea, Pinky Winky *Hydrangea paniculata*



Upright deciduous shrub with dark green leaves and large panicles of flowers that open white and age to pink (with more acidic soil, they become purplish). Plant type – deciduous

- Height 6-8 ft. Width 6-8 ft.
- Soil conditions – prefers moist, well-drained soil
- Good cut or dried flower

## Juniper, Wisconsin *Juniper horizontalis*

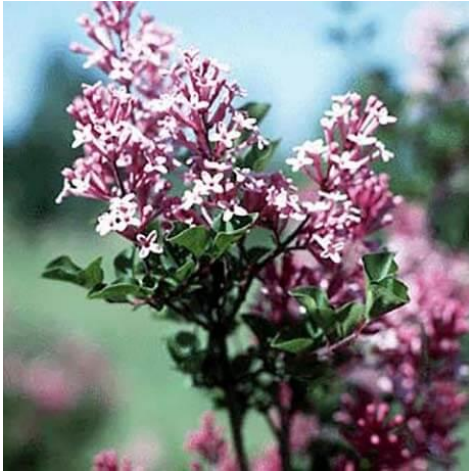
